How to Care for your Permanent Hair Extensions?

Caring for hair extensions is a little different to caring for your normal hair. It is essential that you follow these aftercare tips and recommendations by your stylist. By not caring for your extensions correctly they will not last as long as they should, resulting in wasted time and money. Remember these are 100% human Remy hair, which means they are manufactured with the hair cuticle flowing in same direction, reducing the possibility of the hair mating or tangling

Hair extension and can be coloured and styled as your own, however we strongly advise against ever performing a chemical service at home. Always seek the advice of your professional stylist.

Hair extensions should not be more than twice the length of your normal hair. When sleeping never go to bed with wet extensions, and always work the hair into a loose braid, this will help prevent tangling and other such problems. In the morning run your fingers through the braids to get rid of any tangles then style as desired. Be gentle when brushing your extensions as excessive tugging can loosen the wefts. Use a soft bristle brush or a paddle brush and work your way up from bottom to top. It is always advised to put a protection cream in or wear a swimming cap when swimming in chlorine.

Washing your hair

Keep your hair clean. Build up from sweat and dirt will tangle the hair. Always wash your hair after exercise, especially swimming. Gently brush your hair before washing it to remove all tangles. When shampooing your extensions it is advised that you don't do so upside down, wash standing up stroking in a downward motion. Use a good quality shampoo and conditioner that your stylist has recommended for you. First - apply shampoo gently, always stroking in a downward motion allowing the product to run through to the ends of the hair. Rinse thoroughly. Second - follow the same procedure with your conditioner, gently comb through with a wide tooth comb. Again make sure it has been rinsed thoroughly.

Styling your hair

Once your hair has been washed and gently combed, you can now dry it. Spray or rub in a leave- in conditioner that doesn't contain too much alcohol as it will dry out the hair. It is always better for your hair and the extension hair if you allow it to dry naturally. If you need your hair styled or you are in a rush, blow-drying is fine with the right heat protection products as recommended by your stylist. Because the extensions are attached in wefts using rings, frequent blow drying with heavy pulling of a brush will cause stress on the wefts and may cause them to slip out faster. We recommend that you finger dry your hair using a heat protection product, style as desired using a styling iron.

Treating your hair

Do not ever perm, colour or perform any chemical service with out the professional consult of your stylist, as some chemical services should never be attempted on the extensions.
